

## Frequently Asked Questions

### And Important Dates

1. What do I need to do now that registration is complete?
  - a. Start gathering the necessary equipment that your child will need. Players are responsible for furnishing their own equipment to include helmets w/ face bars, shoulder pads and pants with pads. The league will furnish a game jersey. **Helmets must be N.O.C.A.S.E. approved.**
  - b. Athletic shoes or molded rubber cleats must be worn. NO screw – in or metal cleats allowed.
2. Where do I get the equipment?
  - a. Any sporting goods store in the metro area.
3. When is the Evaluation Day for tackle players?
  - a. Saturday August 15<sup>th</sup>. All players will need to report to Traceway Park.
  - b. 9 – 10 Y/O Must report at 11:00 am.
  - c. 11 – 12 Y/O Must report at 11:00 am.
4. What do you need for Evaluation Day?
  - a. Just Comfortable Clothes, we will be conducting some easy drills.
  - b. Players MUST Bring their copy of Birth Certificate.
5. Will there be a parent's meeting?
  - a. YES, Tackle Football, On the evaluation day parents will meet to discuss the league and expatiations.
  - b. Parents need to report to their players time slot on evaluation day.
  - c. Flag parents will meet with coaches at your first scheduled practice.
6. Is there an evaluation for Flag players.
  - a. NO
7. When are the games played?
  - a. The season should begin around September 14<sup>th</sup>. Games for Tackle will be Monday and Tuesday nights at Traceway Park and Robinson Park. The season should be over by November 14<sup>th</sup>.
  - b. The Flag games will be played on Thursday's at Traceway Park and Robinson Park.
8. When will I know what team My player is on?
  - a. We will have a draft sometime before the Wednesday following the evaluation. Your assigned coach should contact you that Thursday or Friday.
  - b. Flag players will be assigned to teams and your coach will contact you Thursday or Friday.
